## How can Homeless Outreach Specialists help?

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Coulee Collaborative to End Homelessness is partnering with Independent Living Resources to provide Homeless Outreach Program services in the Coulee Region. Homeless Outreach Specialists are trained and available to assist individuals and families who are homeless with the following services:

- Accessing shelter
- Obtaining necessary emergency physical and mental healthcare
- Completing an assessment for supportive housing programs
- Developing a housing stability plan
- Addressing barriers to obtaining and maintaining housing
- Applying for subsidized, income-based and market rate housing

Each person receives individualized assistance to achieve their housing goals and assessment for referral to other community support services.
